MEMORANDUM FOR Members of the Bench

SUBJECT: Amendment of the Servicemembers Civil Relief Act (SCRA)

1. Public Laws 111-275 and 111-346, enacted in October and December, 2010, respectively, each modified the SCRA to further benefit servicemembers.
2. PL 111-275, otherwise known as the Veterans' Benefits Act of 2010, modified the language of the SCRA regarding residential and motor vehicle leases and telephone service contracts. As to leases, the language was changed to clarify the qualifications for applicability without changing the substantive protections. The language dealing with telephone service was completely rewritten. The new language strengthens the protections by expressly including "Family Plans" where the servicemember is a beneficiary of the contract, or where the other beneficiaries of the contract are affected by the servicemember's change of station. (PL 111-275, Sec 301-303.)
3. PL 111-346, otherwise known as the Helping Heroes Keep Their Homes Act of 2010, extended the provisions of the Housing and Economic Recovery Act of 2008 regarding foreclosure protections for servicemembers. That act extended the foreclosure protection measures of the SCRA from 90 days after the period of service to 9 months after the period of service. That extension was set to expire on 31 Dec 2010, but has been extended by the new act until 31 Dec 2012. Starting 1 Jan 2013, the previous 90 days of protection will go back into effect. (PL 111-346, Sec 2.)
