PRE-REGISTRATION AND DEPOSIT:

We are now accepting deposits for the 2012 program. We expect the program to reach capacity again this year. This pre-registration opportunity is for guest students who would like to take advantage of reserving a spot prior to the full brochure release and application period. The special pre-registration deposit for the Australia program is \$250 and is nonrefundable. A spot in the program will be reserved for 2 weeks after regular enrollment begins. During that time a \$250 enrollment confirmation deposit must be submitted. The enrollment confirmation deposit is nonrefundable as of October 15, 2011. The deposits are credited toward your tuition and fees.

Return the completed pre-registration application and \$250 nonrefundable pre-registration deposit to the address below. Guest students may arrange with us to charge the deposit fee to a credit card. The deposit fee may also be paid by check or money order made payable to Thomas M. Cooley Law School.

The 2012 program is scheduled to begin on January 2nd and end April 14th. Brochures and applications should be available in June. 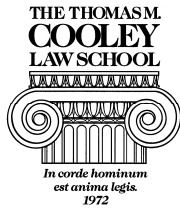
