APPLICATION AND DEPOSIT: Return the completed application and \$500 deposit (which is credited toward your tuition and fees) by October 15, 2011 to: Associate Dean William Weiner, Thomas M. Cooley Law School, 300 South Capitol Avenue, Lansing, MI 48933. Guest students may arrange with us to charge the deposit to a credit card. The deposit may also be paid by check or money order made payable to Thomas M. Cooley Law School. \$250 is refundable prior to October 15, 2011, after which the entire deposit is nonrefundable. Full payment of tuition and fees is due by December 1, 2011. Proof of a valid passport, a photo for identification purposes, a letter of good standing, and your official law school transcript must be submitted as soon as possible.
