Six students were nominated for the James Wilson Class Distinguished Student Award. Nominees were also personally interviewed as part of the selection process.

Members of each graduating class are evaluated on the criteria of character, academic accomplishment, leadership and extracurricular activities in the process of deciding to grant the Distinguished Student Award.
