# *Theodore W. Swift*

Dedication of the Theodore W. Swift Welcome Center at the Thomas M. Cooley Law School took place Monday, July 16, 2001, at 4:30 p.m. The Welcome Center is located near the Admissions Office on the second floor of the law school's newest building, the Cooley Center. Theodore (Ted) Swift passed away unexpectedly in February 2000. He had practiced law nearly his entire career at the prestigious law firm bearing his name, Foster, Swift, Collins & Smith. Ted was a well-known and much admired attorney who took a sabbatical from the practice of law to serve as a visiting professor of law at the Thomas M. Cooley Law School, and after returning to his practice, continued as an adjunct professor.

"This is a fitting tribute to Ted who was a fine lawyer, a teacher to so many more than the students he taught at Cooley, and a leader in the community," said Mike Sanders, president of Foster, Swift, Collins & Smith, P.C.
