CHRONOTRACK® TIMED

The Race for Education will be using the ChronoTrack system. The ChronoTrack system is an innovation that allows for the use of disposable tags called D-Tags. The ChronoTrack system simplifies the timing process for athletes. A disposable tag means that the athlete will be in shorter lines before the race to pick up a bib and chip and in no line to return a tag or chip after the race. The D-Tag is easy to attach to a shoe and is far lighter and less intrusive than other timing tags and chips.

DIVISION AWARDS

Awards to the overall male and female winners and master's winners:

Age group awards to the top three finishers, male and female. 9 & under, 10-14, 15-19, 20-24, 25-29, 30-34, 35-39, 40-44, 45-49, 50-54, 55-59, 60-64, 65-69, 70-74, 75-79, 80 & up, wheeler.

SCHOOL COMPETITION AWARD

New this year is a competition between schools or educational institutions. Cooley Law School will make school competition awards of \$1,000 for 1st place (the school with the most nominations from the race entries), \$750 for 2nd place, and \$500 for 3rd place. In the event of a tie, a random selection drawing will determine placement. For instance, should there be a tie for 1st place, a drawing will determine the 1st and 2nd place winners and the school with the next highest number nominations will be the 3rd place winner. Only three of the School Competition Awards will be given. Each nomination that has a specific designation will be considered a separate nomination.

The School Competition Awards are in addition to the drawing for race proceeds; see below.

RACE PROCEEDS

After announcing the School Competition Awards, we will draw the names of race entrants and distribute the race proceeds to the educational institution named on the entrants' race forms according to the following formula:

- First drawing winner: 50% of the proceeds
- Second drawing winner: 25% of the proceeds
- Third drawing winner: 10% of the proceeds
- Fourth drawing winner: 10% of the proceeds
- Fifth drawing winner: 5% of the proceeds

Checks will be sent directly to each of the winning educational institutions after the final accounting for both the School Competition Awards and for race proceeds winners.
